Background information

The Berlin International Film Festival is one of the world's leading film festivals. Founded in 1951, the festival has been celebrated annually in February since 1978. It was established by the Americans after World War II in an attempt to return Berlin to how it was before the war. Alfred Hitchcock's film 'Rebecca' opened the first festival. The awards are called the Golden and Silver Bears.

The Festival is Berlin's largest cultural event and also one of the most important dates on the international film industry's calendar. It is a massive event with more than 200,000 tickets sold and up to 400 films shown each year. Films are shown in glamorous cinemas across the city. For two weeks, art, glamour, parties and business take place at the *Berlinale*. It has become a good rival for the Cannes Film Festival.



Teaching activities

- ◆ Write a newspaper report of the latest festival. Who won? Why? Make up a quotation from them. What did they wear? Describe their film.
- ◆ Record or act out a short television broadcast showing live from the event.
- ◆ Compare statistics from the Cannes Film Festival and the Berlin Film Festival. Which one would you choose to go to? Why?
